As the saying goes, "A hero is known in the time of misfortune (不幸)". Zhong Nanshan is a hero like this. He is a doctor in Guangdong, who 31 many people's lives in 2003.

In 2003, SARS 32 in Guangdong. Later, it spread across China and other parts of the world. Patients coughed a lot and got fevers. Hundreds of 33 even died from the

He advised people to wear masks, 38 hands frequently (频繁地), stay at home and not to go to crowded places.

Zhong likes sports very much. 39 he was 67, he could still play basketball. Now at the age of 84, Zhong still treats patients in the hospital and 40 young doctors. "I am just a doctor." Zhong says. But we think he is a hero and a fighter.

Chinese billionaire has said that the world's best CEO will be a robot within the next 30 years. The 52-year-old founder of Alibaba warned that robots will bring far more pain than happiness in the next 30 years. But he added that artificial intelligence(人工智能) will finally improve our everyday lives in the future.

Ma, who is worth \$28.4 billion, said that improvement in technology will make CEOs unimportant within the next 30 years.

"In 30 years, a robot will likely be on the cover of Time Magazine as the best CEO" Ma said in a speech at an entrepreneurship(创业) meeting. He said that robots would get the world's top jobs because they are "quicker and more rational(理性的)" than humans. He added that they would be fitter for CEOs because they won't be influenced by their emotions, such as getting annoyed with their competitors.

He also warned that the world is not yet ready for the changes that will be brought by the invention of robots. He pointed out that schools must teach children to be more creative to deal with the rise of artificial intelligence. Ma compared the coming wide use of robots to the rise of the Internet in the 90s. He said he tried to warn people that online shops would badly influence the traditional business, but few people listened. He added that society should actively prepare for the changes robots will bring to get used to the new world of artificial intelligence.

Changing Weather

The weather is changing. Over the last few years, heavy rains have caused floods in Brazil, Pakistan, and Thailand. Droughts (干旱) have struck Russia and Australia. Heat waves have killed thousands in Europe. There are more different kinds of terrible wild weather all over the world. In 2011 alone, the bad weather caused the world to lose 150 billion dollars.

Warmer and Wetter

As more wild weather (极端天气) events happen, a worried world is beginning to ask questions like: What is going on with the weather? And why? Many also want to know: Is this natural, or are we to blame (责备)?

The answer seems to be: a little of both. Wild weather is natural. But most scientists agree human activity has made the Earth warmer. This global warming(全球变暖) makes heat waves more likely happen. The higher temperature also causes more water to enter the air. This causes much more rain. Some scientists also believe global warming makes some storms stronger.

This means we're likely to see more wild weather. "But we don't have to just stand there and take it," says Scientist Michael Oppenheimer. He and other scientists say we need to stop the Earth from getting warmer. We also need to be prepared, to do things that will help save lives.

Most of you will enter high school this fall. By that time, you'll find yourself immersed in traditional Chinese culture.

In January, the Ministry of Education worked out a new set of curriculum standards (课程标准) for high school students, People's Daily reported. One of the biggest changes will be a greater focus on traditional Chinese culture.

According to Professor Han Zhen from Beijing Foreign Language Studies University, the new standards echo (回应) President Xi Jinping's call for strengthening education. "The standards help students build cultural confidence," he told People's Daily.

The new standards call for students to be able to recite 72 ancient poems or articles. The number used to be 14. Recommended classic literature from ancient China includes The Analects of Confucius (《论语》), Records of the Grand Historian (《史记》) and more.

Apart from Chinese language, other subjects such as fine arts, music and physical education will also focus more on traditional Chinese culture. For example, fine arts will include new lessons on Chinese calligraphy (书法) and painting.

China has also seen a growing interest in traditional culture in the private education sector (领域). According to Southern Metropolitan Daily, since 2004, more than 3,000 traditional private schools have been built. They mainly teach traditional Chinese classics.

The students may be too young to understand some classics. However, as their life experience builds up, they may develop their own thoughts about the wisdom of the classics, which could be a driving force for their growth. -
